The Czech Republic, a country of nearly 11 million people, is located in central Europe. The capital city, Prague, has a population of 1.2 million people and is considered one of the most beautiful cities in all of Europe.

Czech has a rich religious history, but according to the last census, almost 90% of Czechs identify themselves as atheists. This atheism in Czech isn't an intellectual atheism formed by many years of study. Instead, most Czechs have never thought about God and do not know anyone who would identify themselves as a follower of Jesus.

For most Czechs, faith is for the weak, the elderly, and the poor. Churches are the cathedrals that litter the landscape, sit empty most of the year, and are visited only by their grandparents or tourists.

what's it look like?

The STINT experience varies from individual to individual, with the average STINT usually lasting 9-24 months. Two facets exist within the STINT experience in the Czech Republic - 1) Reaching athletic influencers at the Sports University in Prague and 2) competing in your sport to see God reach your teammates, coaches, and more.

The future athletic influencers are students at the Sports University in Prague and you would work with other short-term and long-term staff to reach students who study at this school. It is here that we do outreach activities and teach conversational English classes to engage students in thinking about spiritual things.

We have relationships with many on the inside of sports world and our desire would be to place you on a team in Prague. Your goal would be to be a teammate who continually talks to people about Jesus. You would practice, play, and travel with your team looking for opportunities to share the life changing message of Jesus with those you encounter.

But how are they to call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching?
